TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. The proprietors are responsible for the efficient running of the site and for the welfare of visitors. They may refuse entry to, or the use of, the site by any persons and should they consider it necessary, to request the removal of any vehicle or tent/unit. The refund of the appropriate portion of any rental paid shall be sufficient discharge of all obligations to any person who is required by them to vacate the site.
2. All visitors must book in at reception upon arrival.
3. Caolasnacon Caravan Park and any of its employees shall not be held liable for any loss or damage occasioned to any person, vehicle, tent, caravan or its contents, while on the site, howsoever any such loss or damage shall be occasioned, nor for any consequential loss.
4. No overcrowding of any form of accommodation shall be allowed.
5. Drivers of vehicles on the site are requested to drive slowly and carefully at all times and to observe all speed limits.
6. In the interests of hygiene and general public health all site users are asked to keep the toilet buildings, dish washing area and laundry as clean and tidy as possible. Do not leave taps running or put cigarette ends, or any other articles likely to cause obstruction, into basins, sinks, WCs or any other drain.
7. Chemical closets must be emptied into the disposal point provided and must have the relevant chemical added – no raw sewage please. Please do not allow waste bins to overflow in caravans. All receptacles used for the collection of waste water must be emptied down a site drain at the stand pipes.
8. Please help to keep the site tidy by recycling in the appropriately marked recycling bins.
9. Please do not use the sinks in the toilet block for washing of dishes or large items of clothing.
10. Music devices and instruments must not be used to the annoyance of other site visitors.
11. Dogs are permitted on the site provided they are kept on a lead. There are ample facilities available outside the confines of the site for walking dogs and they must not be allowed to soil the ground within the site.
12. Firearms of any kind are not allowed on site.
13. Any camp fires must be on the shore and not on the grass and any mess cleared away. Portable BBQs must be placed on a slab or stones to avoid scorching the grass.
